Golden Technologies operates a corn wet milling facility which processes approximately 30,000 bushels of corn per day. A set of four 35-foot-diameter silos and a 300,000-bushel steel bin were erected to allow 75-car-unit trains to be received and unloaded within 18 hours. A 470-foot-long inclined bridge with a belt conveyor provides corn to the plant.

Loadout equipment was installed on a slipformed building fitted with steel tanks above the driveway and receiving equipment below grade. Steel cone hoppers were also installed in the silos to provide a work area and equipment access.

Construction was completed in approximately nine months, starting in mid-spring and finishing around the year's end.
