The Pilgrim's Pride project is comprised of a slipformed concrete feed processing tower, an attached warehouse, a detached slipformed grain storage unit, a detached office, a truck maintenance facility, and 3,000 feet of rail siding. Located in the feed mill are 2,100 tons of ingredient storage and 1,200 tons of finished feed storage. A total of 133,000 bushels of whole grain is stored in the silos.

Processing equipment includes grinding, batching, mixing, and pelleting, with handling equipment for truck and rail receiving. Truck loadout is through a shuttle conveyor system. Site development involved 50,000 cubic yards of earthwork.
