This facility includes a single truck receiving pit at 20,000 bushels per hour, three 49,000-bushel GSI cone bottom bins, one 600-foot-long InterSystems Model 48 barge loading belt conveyor, and one 60,000-bushel-per-hour Premier Fabrication spout.
