This project represents the second of Cargill's two new flour mills for the west coast markets. Younglove previously built a 7,000 cwt flour milling facility near San Bernardino, California, in 1988.

Cargill provided construction management services by coordinating the work of three prime contractors, along with the bulk of equipment and system purchases. Younglove responsibilities, as one of the prime contractors, included site development, utilities, design and construction of all buildings and structures, and installation of wheat receiving, distribution, and transfer equipment. Other firms were responsible for electrical and mill mechanical.

Due to being built in California, the pre-permitting process started almost 18 months prior to the start of actual construction. Once construction started, however, due to the cooperation of local building officials, along with the communication efforts of the Cargill personnel and the various contractors, facility operation took place in a very un-California-type schedule of approximately 13 months, meeting a very optimistic target date.
